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INTRODUCTION

This book adds to the vast array of messages that touch on the temple of God. The deliverance and victory we seek comes only after the outpour of the spirit of God. Awareness in relation to our true nature and God's kingdom comes forth as the spirit is poured upon us. The spirit comes to teach us all things concerning our inheritance in God and leads us into that inheritance.
