

NOAH, SIGN- POST FOR THE AGES



Luke 17:26-27 And as it was in the days of Noah, so it will be also in the days of the Son of Man: 27 They ate, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and the flood came and destroyed them all.

When Jesus spoke these words (**Luke 17:26-27**) to His disciples, He was standing in His eternal place upon mount Zion, in other words He was speaking from the spirit. To this very day He is speaking these same words which He spoke well over two thousand years ago, however only His true disciples, those who have ears to hear, who will ever be able to perceive that voice of the spirit. As He speaks, He only testifies to the truth and leads all men who are perishing in the curse of Adam to the place of life and peace in the heart of God the Father. All who recognize His voice as he speaks through the spirit in the inner parts will awake to a new world of pleasures hidden in God.

These verses are very common verses which are preached and known all over the world today; it is very important because show a trend that will occur at the end of this present system of things and the appearing of the Christ (The Savior of the world), the verses further warn of impending destruction for those who do not hearken to the call to obedience in Christ Jesus. This piece of scripture instills fear in men because it has been perceived as the final appearing and final destruction of the ungodly.

All forms of religion point to some form of end of this world system of unrighteousness and the judgment of the wicked on the face of the earth. Natural Man in His inner consciousness is aware of the fact that there is a kind of responsibility bestowed upon Him; He recognizes the fact that there is a recompense for His works in relation to God and other men. The problem though is

that most men do not have a full revelation of how God intents to carry out His much anticipated judgment upon this world.

Most expect some form of end to the physical world, meaning that all things in this material realm will come to naught in a grinding halt. Some have erroneously used prophecies from the bible to buttress their conviction that this material world will be destroyed by some form of fire, tsunami or nuclear bomb etc. For these reason some people are constantly on the look out for events in the Middle East or geographical events and signs. Many eloquent end-time soothsayers have appeared over the years and do continue to appear preaching of the end of the world, some of these men who are highly skilled in the letters of the Bible use verses from the bible in combination with historic trend as instrument to propagate their beliefs to multitudes; some use biblical verses like Peter's scripts to claim that the world will be destroyed by some form of seen fire. They say in the same way the world was overrun in flood water and destroyed in the days of Noah, so will this world be destroyed, but this time it will be wiped out by fire, bring an end to this physical world system and ushering God's world from heaven [2 Peter 3:1-13].

We need to have a clear understanding of what God is talking about in relation to the much anticipated end of the world and the emergence of a new world system and the coming of God's only begotten son in great power and in glory. Our knowledge of these things is not to add to our knowledge for egoistic purposes but for our edification. Spiritual intelligence and understanding comes forth from the spirit, to lead us into eternal Excellency and safety in the hands of the Lord. If we perceive these things with our carnal human reasoning we can not in any way get any tangible thing out of these prophecies we will only receive ministration of fear, uncertainty and death.

The story on Noah was divinely ordered and predestined by the will of God for the glory of those who are called to partake of His

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divine nature. It reveals from the deep resources of God's mind, an **event that occurs eternally from generation to generation**; it reveals **the ages to come in God's kingdom, the end of this present system of things, the destruction of the wicked and the saving grace of the Lord**. Other questions are also answered within the scope of Noah's story such as **our true origin and divinity in God, the mystery of iniquity and our escape route from destruction and many others**.

Noah received a divine warning from the Lord by revelation and therefore built and entered an Ark in which He eventually escaped the destruction and wasting of the system of His time. He was then ushered into a new world order because of His obedience; he became heir of righteousness that is according to faith [**Hebrews 11:7**].

The sign of Noah is an eternal sign for all ages especially for those who have ears to hear. I say a sign for all ages because of in truth, prophecies of God are continuous and present, therefore they can in no way be boxed up in time frames according to the reasoning of men. The physical material world continues, it may be molded and remolded but it will never end. Someone may ask that "what does the end of this world mean then?" This book will answer this widely misunderstood subject which has been understood by men from all spheres of life.

Noah was one who found grace in His generation and therefore tasted of the salvation of God; in likewise manner, God's salvation is revealed from generation to generation to those who find this grace to hear and obey the Lord. We should also understand that He (The Lord) came and revealed His saving hand in the days of Jesus and ever since He has been doing the same. That generation of people that saw Jesus in the flesh is gone. The message of God's grace and His kingdom was preached to them, some received it while others did not. The Lord also revealed His saving hand during the days of the Apostles and is still doing the same

thing today but most people tend not to discern God as He moves by His Spirit. Only those who have their eyes and ears spiritually opened can discern the mighty work of God's deliverance as he moves by His spirit.

I say to those that have ears to discern because not all discern these precious words of the Lord as it goes forth. We should take time out to understand what God intends to communicate to us. He speaks by His spirit in diverse ways; He speaks through the testimonies in the bible and through the Physical creation that we behold. The physical creation and events in it are physical manifestation of His Thoughts in material form. The teacher (Christ) uses this physical manifestation of God's thoughts to teach His disciples and instruct them in the ways of God. If we are not carried away with the physical appearances and concentrate on the message behind them, we begin to see light.

Noah was able to perceive and receive from God and therefore saved His soul and those of His household, simply because He listened and obeyed the Lord. Others heard Noah preach and warn of impending destruction, they also saw Noah laboring day and night to build the ark, but being carried away with the trading for gain of the world and other forms of activities of their time they became dull of hearing the voice that is able to save their soul. That which distinguished Noah from the others was his ability to **PERCEIVE** what the Lord was saying and to **ACT** upon it.

Hebrews 11:7 7 By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.

Noah had the vision of a new world order that was to come; He had a revelation of the end of the world system that He lived
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in. He received this revelation by faith and worked by faith towards it. Remember that we who are Christ's have this same privilege today, because we have His spirit which teaches us all things and shows us things to come. The spirit of Christ also leads us into a new age in Christ known as God's kingdom.

John 16:13

13 However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

When Jesus mentions things to come, He is talking about the righteous kingdom of God that is coming to view before all. He is not talking about predicting the future of world events like wars, deaths, disasters etc. Of course God might reveal these things to people, but understand that the real interpretation of **things to come** is simply pointing to the new world order of righteousness and peace in Christ Jesus. It is the world where all are reconciled to God; it is God's own kingdom.

Using Noah's testimony, we will by the Spirit of God browse through the scriptures to see what God intended to reveal to generations past, our generation and generations to come concerning His eternal purposes in Christ Jesus.

Some of the things you read might sound deep initially, just ask the father dwelling in you by the spirit to teach you. Aren't you His sons? If your son after the flesh asks for bread to satisfy His hunger, wouldn't you give Him? If you being of the stock of fallen man (Adam) can do that, how much more will your true heavenly Father give you His spirit of wisdom (bread of life) if we sincerely ask.
